Dear Quiz Contestants,

Back by popular demand....the Annual Lord's Taverners Quiz!

We have really enjoyed putting it together, and we hope that it will be fun for you, your family and friends. If you are playing as a group, can we suggest the following?

- Split your Group into equal teams. 4 per team is the ideal number!
- The quiz consists of up to 140 questions in 7 rounds, each of 20 questions.
- We have enclosed a Joker, which each team can play once during the quiz, to double the score for that round.
- Don't reveal the titles of all 7 rounds at the beginning but announce only the title of the next round and ask the teams to decide if they want to play their joker on that round, before handing it out.
- Once the decision has been made and the round distributed it is too late for teams to change their mind!
- If the joker has not been played before the last round it automatically goes on round 7.
- Time allowed per round is c. 15 minutes. State "a few minutes to go" and gauge the reaction from the room as to whether teams have finished.
- Swap papers for marking and record the marks. (Easier if you do this cumulatively).

We would suggest that you undertake the quiz in the following sequence:




